## DR SIMON LIEW

Dr Liew is a Sydney trained Ophthalmologist and was a cornea fellow at the University of Glasgow, Scotland. Dr Liew specialises in cornea and anterior segment diseases and cataract surgery.

Dr Liew is proficient in the latest techniques in Corneal Lamella Graft surgery (DALK, DSEAK) and Cross Linking procedures. He is a visiting medical officer at Royal Prince Alfred Hospital Sydney. He consults at our Parramatta, Castle Hill and Penrith rooms.

A corneal transplant is recommended for people who have: Vision problems caused by thinning of the cornea, most often due to keratoconus. Scarring of the cornea from severe infections or injuries. DALK is used to remove the diseased front part of the cornea, leaving behind the healthy endothelial cells. Vision loss caused by cloudiness of the cornea, most often due to Fuchs dystrophy. Descemet Stripping Automated Endothelial Keratoplasty DSAEK is a partial thickness cornea transplant procedure that involves selective removal of the patient's Descemet membrane and endothelium, followed by transplantation of donor corneal endothelium in addition to donor corneal stroma. It results in a optically pure interface and has excellent visual recovery.

We want to ensure you have good support and can be driven to and from your surgery and post operative visits. We ask that you don't use public transport during this time.


We ask that you only bring one support person with you on the day of your procedure.
